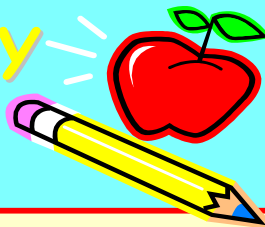

## News from Rooms

**Babies:** This term we are doing lots of painting and craft activities relating to Summer and Under the Sea. We have enjoyed the body painting recently, so we will probably revisit this later in the term, so be prepared! Sand and water play will feature heavily throughout the term and we look forward to the weather improving so that we can go outside and enjoy the sunshine and the wheeled toys.
