Babies and Tweenies: The Babies and Tweenies enjoy taking part in many varied and exciting activities and by using their fine motor skills, they will be creating autumn animals and trees in collage. They will be threading all sorts of objects and exploring textures in the 'tuff tray', such as jelly, custard, ice, paints and natural objects. The children will continue to learn about colours and shapes and be encouraged to take part with songs and rhymes and are creating their very own nursery rhyme display and a new family tree display, with special family photographs. The outdoor areas at Birchfield are vast and the children will be enjoying nature walks, collecting pine cones and leaves.

Toddlers & Intermediates: During their Nature Detective activities, the Toddlers and Intermediates will continue to look at the changes in the environment as the seasons alter. The children, who have recently joined the Toddlers and Intermediates, have settled well and are enjoying making new friends as well as cementing their current friendships. This term they will be taking part in lots of fun activities to develop their self confidence, concentration, sharing and turn taking skills, as well as focusing on continuing to learn more about shapes and colours through creative autumn activities and celebrations.
