News from the Rooms

Babies: We would like to welcome the new children to the Baby Room and wish them many happy years with us. The babies have been exploring different materials and making collages of creatures under the sea. We have also made 'mirrors' to look at ourselves and our differences and we are exploring the five senses as part of our 'Me, Myself, I' theme. The babies continue to enjoy 'Sing and Sign' with Wendy and her team and the experience of the outdoors.

Tweenies: The Room Leader, Amy and the ladies in the Tweenie Room would like to welcome all the new children who have joined the room. The Tweenies have been enjoying mark making activities by using leaves, pine cones and sticks to explore colour and texture. We have been outside exploring the weather, splashing in puddles and going on nature walks around the extensive grounds of Birchfield School.

Toddlers: The new children have settled well into the Toddler Room. We have enjoyed exploring the outdoor areas, especially during our Nature Detective Sessions, where we have been hunting for bugs and finding hidden objects in the trees. We have been taking part in group circle time and talking about ourselves, our families and things that we like, such as toys, animals, colours and places to visit. We have also enjoyed dancing to action songs and rhymes, using whole body movements.
