# <u>Sickness</u>

If your child has been unwell, please let the team know. Remember if a child has had sickness or diarrhoea, its 48 hours from the last bout before they can come back to nursery.

If your child has had Calpol before coming to nursery, please let us know too. It's important that you let us know so that we can keep your child safe.

We can only administer Calpol if your child has a temperature over 38 degrees and after a discussion with you on the phone. We cannot just give it every 4 hours unless it has been prescribed by a GP as part of a course of treatment.

Please allow 24 hours of antibiotics before your child returns to nursery.
