My daughter Niamh Duncan is in Preschool 2 and has been attending Moreton Hall nursery for the past year and we couldn't be happier with the choice we made in sending her here. The staff are friendly, approachable and professional. We receive regular daily EyLog messages about Niamh's progress, next steps and activities she has done. The activities provided are varied and vast, Niamh loves the weekly forest school sessions and we like the extra curricular opportunities provided, such as the swimming lessons. When we collect Niamh from nursery a member of staff will always take the time to give us a full update of how she has been and what she has been up to. The staff are also available to answer and questions or queries I have about her learning. When we have added observations on Niamh's eyLog her keyworker Karri, has used this as a starting point to develop activities linked to Niamh's interests and learning needs. Niamh loves attending Moreton Hall nursery and is very happy and settled here.

We were so pleased with the care provided by Moreton Hall nursery for my daughter that we decided to enroll my son Noah Duncan in the Toddler class in January 2019. Moreton Hall nursery provided lots of opportunities for Noah to have transition sessions prior to starting which allowed him to meet the staff, children and get used to the classroom. Although, through no fault of the nursery, Noah has struggled with settling when I drop him off in the morning. However. Moreton Hall nursery have been so supportive and encouraging with addressing his needs that they provide an extra transition session once a week for him, which is helping no end. Even though Noah is sad when I drop him off I know he is safe and being cared for well by the staff in the toddler room, in particular Jo and Jayne who he has made a real bond with. It's great that I receive an eyLog update during Noah's morning to assure me he has settled with pictures and information about what he has been up to. We are also given a daily dairy for Noah to let us know what he's eaten, when he had his nappy changed and what activities they've been doing, I've also been kept well informed about Noah's change in key worker (ahead of her impending maternity leave) and love that his new key worker has been spending lots of time getting to know Noah ahead of this change.

In my opinion this nursery provides outstanding care for my two children and I believe it's well managed by Zoe, whom I feel is very dedicated and accommodating to our needs, especially when asking for a shorter session for Noah. I would highly recommend this nursery.
