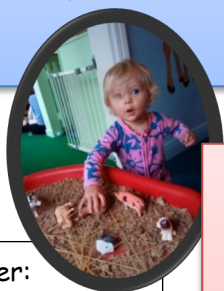


# Babies Autumn Newsletter

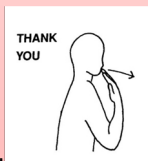

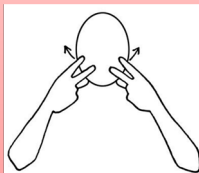
We use lots of Makaton signs within the baby room and its never too early for you to start at home. Below are just a few we use that you might see you baby also do at home.
