Tweenie Room


The Tweenies have started learning Makaton this month in a natural and fun way, and through real life experiences, which allows the children to use the sings of the week in context.

The children have loved exploring and looking at their family board, which contains photographs from home – thank you for sending these in! This gives them the opportunity to share their experiences and helps them to recall past events and significant people.

The classroom has been adapted and changed recently, providing more space for the children to use the home corner, and to build effectively, as well as use the cosy den to read lots of stories and share books.

The tweenies have also been continuing to develop their independent skills, scraping their plates after lunch, washing their hands and choosing their own snacks.

This week the children have loved food tasting with some interesting and exotic fruits – this has coincided with their sing of the week, which is ‘to eat’.

Our observation process

Over the last few weeks we have been reviewing and updating our observation, planning and assessment process. Following this, we will be moving to a system where we record observations of the children's learning and carrying out next steps once every 2 weeks. The reason for this, is so that the activities can be more tailored to each child's individual learning, rather than doing blanket learning for all the children, whether it is significant for them or not. This obviously comes with an increase in work load for the staff team, and so to ensure this is manageable, observations will be taken and sent home once every 2 weeks. Rest assured, children will still be engaging in exciting learning every week! We will just be changing the way we record and deliver the learning.
